
## BACKGROUND

- [1] The appellants appeal from the Notice of Proposal issued by the Registrar to revoke the registrations of Kanavdeep Gill and Captain Auto Group Corp. o/a Captain Auto Group (collectively the “appellants”) as a motor vehicle salesperson and dealer, respectively, under the *Motor Vehicle Dealers Act., 2002*, S.O. 2002, c. 30, Sched B and the Regulations (the “Act”).
- [2] The parties advised the Tribunal that they had resolved the issues in dispute and both parties have consented to the registration of the appellants as a motor vehicle salesperson and a motor vehicle dealer under the *Act* on terms and conditions set out in the Terms and Conditions of Registration between the appellants and the respondent, signed by the appellants and the respondent on April 9, 2026. The Terms and Conditions of Registration shall constitute Schedule A.
- [3] Further, both parties confirmed that pursuant to section 4.1 of the *Statutory Powers Procedure Act*, R.S.O. 1990, c. S.22 (the “SPPA”), the parties waive the requirements of a hearing and consent to an Order of the Tribunal to confirm the appellants’ registrations on the Terms and Conditions of Registration set out in Schedule A. A copy of the agreements signed by all parties is attached as Schedule A to this Order.

## ON CONSENT OF THE PARTIES, I ORDER:

- [4] Pursuant to s. 4.1 of the *SPPA* and on the consent of the parties, I dispose of this proceeding on the Terms and Conditions of Registration set out in the agreement signed by the appellants and the respondent on April 9, 2026, a copy of which is attached to this order as Schedule A, which Schedule A is incorporated and made part of this Order.

Pursuant to subsection 6(2) of the *Motor Vehicle Dealers Act, 2002* Kanavdeep Gill ("Gill"), Captain Auto Group Corp. o/a Captain Auto Group (the "Dealer") (collectively, the "Registrants") and the Registrar, *Motor Vehicle Dealers Act, 2002*, ("the Registrar"), in accordance with section 4.1 of the *Statutory Powers Procedure Act*, do hereby waive the requirements of a hearing and consent to an Order of the Licence Appeal Tribunal based upon the following terms and conditions:

1. The Registrants will provide the Registrar with notice in writing, within five days, of any changes to the information provided in obtaining his registration, pursuant to section 31 of Ontario Regulation 333/08.
2. The Registrants will ensure that his registration will not be used to trade in motor vehicles where he knows, or ought to know, that trading motor vehicles will facilitate an illegal or unethical practice.
3. The Registrants will ensure that all personnel, agents, assignees or anyone acting on his behalf are informed of the Terms and Conditions contained in this document to the extent necessary to ensure compliance with these Terms and Conditions.
4. The Registrants will take all reasonable steps to ensure that all statements, documents, or information provided by either of them to staff of Ontario Motor Vehicle Industry Council or representatives of the Registrar are legal, ethical, decent, and truthful.
5. The Registrants will take all reasonable steps to ensure that all statements, documents, or information used or created in the conduct of their business, including maintaining registration and trading in motor vehicles, are legal, ethical, decent, and truthful.

6. The Registrants will not be involved in the falsification of any documents for any purpose and will take all reasonable steps to ensure that no one falsifies any documents on their behalf.
7. The Registrants will not unilaterally change, modify, or amend any document in the conduct of their business, including maintaining their registration and trading in motor vehicles, without the written consent or the issuer of the document or the counterparty. For clarity, this clause applies to documents issued by a person other than the Registrants or has a signatory other than the Registrants.

### **EDUCATION**

8. Gill will enroll in the MVDA Key Elements Course within 90 days of the date of this order and will obtain a passing grade of at least 80%.
9. The Registrants agree to offer to fund the MVDA Key Elements Course to any of its future salespersons within 90 days of being retained in that capacity.

### **ACKNOWLEDGMENT AND UNDERTAKING:**

10. The Registrants admit the allegations in paragraphs 1-8 of the Registrar's Notice of Proposal dated November 9, 2025. The Registrants acknowledge that the admissions contained herein may be used in any subsequent proceeding before the Licence Appeal Tribunal.
11. The Registrants agree and acknowledge that these terms and conditions of registration are in addition to any previously agreed upon terms and conditions of registration.
12. The Registrar is relying on the accuracy and completeness of all documents, statements or information provided by Gill in support of his registration.
13. The documents, information or statements provided to the Registrar are true to the best of the Registrants' knowledge, and belief; and that full answer to all questions, inquiries and requests made by the Registrar in connection with the Registrants' registration have been given.
14. The Registrar may take further administrative action, including a proposal to suspend or revoke registration, arising from any matters that have occurred or may occur related to honesty and integrity, financial responsibility or compliance with these terms and conditions.
15. Independent legal advice has been obtained, or the Registrants have had the opportunity to obtain independent legal advice respecting consent to the Terms and Conditions contained in this document.


