DISMISSAL ORDER

The pre-hearing in this matter was scheduled to commence at 9:30 a.m. on June 3, 2016 by teleconference. Michael Rusek, Counsel representing the Registrar, *Motor Vehicle Dealers Act*, 2002, (the "Registrar") appeared; however, the Appellant did not attend nor did he contact the Tribunal.
