Vincent Palladino ("Palladino") was first registered as a motor vehicle sales person in around September 1992. At all material times, Palladino has been the Director of the Dealer.

During an inspection on or about May 18, 2016, a representative of the Registrar reminded the Dealer of its all-in pricing obligations.

# Dealer's current non-compliance:

#### All-in pricing:

- On or before June 25, 2019, the Dealer advertised a 2019 Mazda 3 GX (VIN JM1BPA71K1102196) with an advertised price of \$23, 295


