SCHEDULE "A" – CONDITIONS OF REGISTRATION

PREAMBLE

- 1. - 5. The Applicant will not drive a motor vehicle without a valid driver's license.
- 6. The Applicant will not apply to be a Dealer.
- 7. The Applicant will not be involved in the process of trading in motor vehicles without the benefit of registration and agrees to be involved in the process of trading motor vehicles only for the dealer to whom he is registered.
- 8. The Applicant will not transfer his registration to another Registrant without first obtaining prior written consent of the Registrar.
- 9. The Applicant agrees that he will not to work for 1207036 ONTARIO LIMITED o/a MOTOR CITY AUTO SALES/THE APPROVAL STORE for a period of four (4) years or 2 renewal cycles from the date of signing of the original terms and conditions.

- 13. Independent legal advice has been obtained or the Applicant has had the opportunity to obtain independent legal advice respecting consent to the Terms and Conditions contained in this document.
