## OVERVIEW

- [1] 11807889 Canada Incorporated o/a Toronto Car Experts, Callum Caughey and Ruslan Ashikbayev (together the "Appellants") appeal the Registrar's Notice of Proposal to Revoke Registration (the "NOP"), dated November 17, 2025, pursuant to the *Motor Vehicle Dealers Act, 2002*, S.O. 2002, c. 30, Sch. B (the "Act") with respect to their registrations as a motor vehicle dealer and motor vehicle salespersons, respectively, under the Act.
- [2] The parties advised the Tribunal that they had resolved the issues in dispute and the parties have consented to the registrations of the Appellants on the terms and conditions set out in Terms and Conditions between the Appellants and the Registrar signed by all parties on April 13, 2026. The Terms and Conditions shall constitute Schedule A.
- [3] Further, the parties confirmed that pursuant to section 4.1 of the *Statutory Powers Procedure Act*, R.S.O. 1990, c. S 2 (the "SPPA"), the parties waive the requirements of a hearing and consent to an Order of the Tribunal to confirm the appellants' registrations on the Terms and Conditions of Registration set out on Schedule A. A copy of the agreements signed by all parties is attached as Schedule A to this Order.

## ON CONSENT OF BOTH PARTIES, I ORDER:

- [4] Pursuant to s. 4.1 of the SPPA and on the consent of the parties, I dispose of the proceeding on the Terms and Conditions set out in the agreement signed by the parties on April 13, 2026, a copy of which is attached to this order as Schedule A, which Schedule A is incorporated and made part of this Order.

Pursuant to subsection 6(2) of the *Motor Vehicle Dealers Act, 2002* Callum Caughey ("Caughey"), Ruslan Ashikbayev ("Ashikbayev"), 11807889 Canada Incorporated o/a Toronto Car Experts (the "Dealer") (collectively, the "Registrants") and the Registrar, *Motor Vehicle Dealers Act, 2002*, ("the Registrar"), in accordance with section 4.1 of the *Statutory Powers Procedure Act*, do hereby waive the requirements of a hearing and consent to an Order of the Licence Appeal Tribunal based upon the following terms and conditions:

1. The Registrants will provide the Registrar with notice in writing, within five days, of any changes to the information provided in obtaining his registration, pursuant to section 31 of Ontario Regulation 333/08.
2. The Registrants will ensure that his registration will not be used to trade in motor vehicles where he knows, or ought to know, that trading motor vehicles will facilitate an illegal or unethical practice.
3. The Registrants will ensure that all personnel, agents, assignees or anyone acting on his behalf are informed of the Terms and Conditions contained in this document to the extent necessary to ensure compliance with these Terms and Conditions.
4. The Registrants will take all reasonable steps to ensure that all statements, documents, or information provided by either of them to staff of Ontario Motor Vehicle Industry Council or representatives of the Registrar are legal, ethical, decent, and truthful.
5. The Registrants will take all reasonable steps to ensure that all statements, documents, or information used or created in the conduct of their business, including maintaining registration and trading in motor vehicles, are legal, ethical, decent, and truthful.

6. The Registrants will not be involved in the falsification of any documents for any purpose and will take all reasonable steps to ensure that no one falsifies any documents on their behalf.
7. The Registrants will not unilaterally change, modify, or amend any document in the conduct of their business, including maintaining their registration and trading in motor vehicles, without the written consent or the issuer of the document or the counterparty. For clarity, this clause applies to documents issued by a person other than the Registrants or has a signatory other than the Registrants.
8. The Registrants will not be involved in the furnishing of documents that have been falsified or contain deceptive information and will take all reasonable steps to ensure that no one furnishes false information on their behalf.


#### EDUCATION

9. Caughey and Ashikbayev will enroll in the MVDA Key Elements Course within 90 days of the date of this order and will obtain a passing grade of at least 80%.

#### ACKNOWLEDGMENT AND UNDERTAKING:


10. The Registrants agree and acknowledge that these terms and conditions of registration are in addition to any previously agreed upon terms and conditions of registration, including the terms and conditions entered into on July 14, 2021.
11. The Registrar may take further administrative action, including a proposal to suspend or revoke registration, arising from any matters that have occurred or may occur related to honesty and integrity, financial responsibility or compliance with these terms and conditions.
12. Independent legal advice has been obtained or the Registrants have had the opportunity to obtain independent legal advice respecting consent to the Terms and Conditions contained in this document.




